Dear Colleagues

It is our great pleasure to invite you to collaborate with the International League of Dermatological Societies (ILDS) through participation at, and sponsorship of, the 3<sup>rd</sup> ILDS World Skin Summit, to be held in Lima, Peru on 13-15 October 2022.

While originally scheduled to take place in 2021, the ILDS Board made the decision to delay the Summit to ensure the rich exchange experienced in person could continue whilst safeguarding delegates' health and not increasing the strain on local healthcare provision. In the meantime, the ILDS continued its commitment to support member organisations response to COVID-19 and to working with the World Health Organization, making sure skin health was considered in the COVID-19 context.

ILDS' growing membership of 195 organisations from over 80 countries around the world will be represented at the Summit by their Presidents and Officers, thereby bringing together a highly influential, skilled and exclusive audience.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> ILDS World Skin Summit, held in 2018, attracted over 100 delegates representing ILDS Member organisations from 40 countries. Dermatology leaders representing various subspecialties of dermatology and geographic regions attended the event to identify and set common goals for skin health.
